

San Francisco Mom Invents **New Changing Pad**

Fed up with the changing pads available on the market today, San Francisco resident and mother of two Grace Welch invented a new patent-pending round changing pad designed to simplify the job of changing diapers.

Called patemm pads™, the round changing pads come in two styles and sizes. The round patemm pad measures 24 inches and has no pockets and The Complete patemm pad, which measures 30 inches and features inside pockets that carry two to four diapers, wipes and a change of clothes and folds simply and cleans easily – simply wipe down and dry. The unique design of the patemm pad features four handles around the pad to ease folding and once folded, an exposed handle folds over the top and an adjacent side handle is used to carry the patemm pad. The current collection of pantemm pads feature fun and hip prints in oil-cloth with other types of fabric in the works. And patemm pads are not just for changing baby - they can also be used as a play mat and to take to mommie and baby yoga or massage classes.
